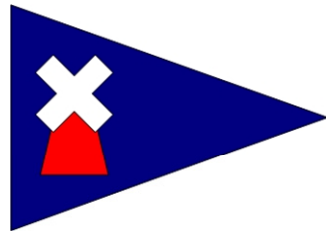


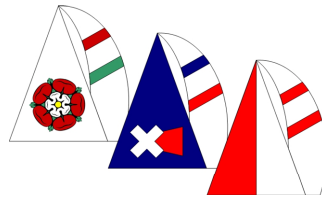

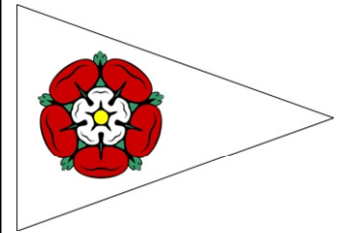

Notice of Race

Eligibility

The series is open to all members of Locks, Langstone and Tudor Sailing Clubs.

Schedule of Races

The following races will be rescored to include eligible members only and then amalgamated into a Long Series using the fleet bandings given below:

Langstone Regatta	14 th July	2 races
Langstone Harbour Race Weekend	25 th August	3 races
Langstone Harbour Race Weekend	26 th August	3 races
Tudor Regatta	8 th September	3 races

Fleets

Fast Handicap	PY <= 1026
Medium Handicap	PY >= 1027

If there are 5 or more entries of the same class then that class will be scored as a separate fleet.

Scoring

Scoring will be in accordance with *Appendix A (Low Point System)*.

Rule A9 (long series) will apply.

Four races shall be completed to constitute a valid series.

Each Class / Helm / Handicap Number combination will be treated as a separate entry for scoring.

The number of races to count in the series will be as follows:

Races sailed:	4	5	6	7	8	9	10	11	12	13	14	15
Races to count:	3	3	4	4	5	5	6	6	7	7	8	8

Langstone Harbour Combined Clubs Series 2018

Race Planning Note

The Langstone Harbour Combined Clubs Series (LHCCS) will comprise all the races from the three club regattas together with races from the Langstone Harbour Race Weekend.

Results will be scored in the fleet bandings stated in the LHCCS NOR, regardless of how the individual races were run.

This requires that each race be run in a manner which will permit this:

- If the PY bands used in an individual race are the same as those in the LHCCS NOR then different courses may be used for different fleets.
- PY bandings different to those in the LHCCS NOR may be used in an individual race provided all boats sail round the same course and have their times and lap count recorded.
